



Teaching Positions at the Scottish Universities' International Summer School

Contemporary British and Irish Theatre and Performance

The Scottish Universities' International Summer School (SUISS) is seeking to appoint a number of tutors for its Contemporary British and Irish Theatre and Performance Course, which runs from **8-19 August 2016**. The two-week course runs parallel to our Contemporary Literature course.

Our Theatre and Performance tutors deliver daily 2-hour seminars based on an assigned list of dramatic texts to groups of international undergraduate- and postgraduate-level students. In addition to teaching the seminar, tutors join their students in attending select morning lectures on the literature course, workshops led by established theatre practitioners, and are invited to participate in the School's busy cultural and social programme, which includes Edinburgh International Festival and Fringe Festival events. Any costs associated with participating in the cultural and social programme are paid for by the School. Tutors are also paid to mark the final assessments submitted by students two weeks after the course.

Applications are invited from PhD students and Postdocs with experience in university teaching and some research expertise in drama and theatre. Further details of the School, as well as a list of core texts, are available on our website: www.suiss.ed.ac.uk.

Please e-mail your Curriculum Vitae (including the contact details of **two references**) and a Cover Letter to the Directors by **Monday, 1 February 2016**, to the email address listed below. The CV should clearly list your theatre experience, and all university teaching experience, including your role, the course subjects, contact hours, numbers of students, and experience of marking assessments. In the Cover Letter, please state clearly your area of research expertise, why you would like to work for SUISS, an overview of your teaching skills and experience, and what you will bring to the tutor position. We receive a high volume of applications each year, so would appreciate if the file names include your full name and the course you are applying for.

Interviews will be held at the University of Edinburgh in late February. For applicants from further afield, we can offer Skype interviews. If hired, SUISS tutors who live outside of Edinburgh will be provided with free accommodation at Pollock Halls, and weekday meals, for the duration of the course.
